

CTA results

The May 2009 CTA examination results are published.

The Chartered Institute of Taxation has published the results from its examinations taken by 1,120 candidates on 12 and 13 May 2009. Commenting on the results, the institute president, Andrew Hubbard, said: 'I would like to offer my congratulations to all 804 of the candidates who have made progress towards becoming a chartered tax adviser and in particular to the 154 people at this sitting who have now completed all of the stages necessary to enable them to become members of the institute. This was the first sitting of our new modular system, under which students do not have to take all of our examinations in a single sitting, and over the next few sittings I confidently expect that the flexibility which we have now built into our examinations will allow more students to come through to full membership'.

ATT results

The May 2009 ATT examination results are published.

The Association of Taxation Technicians has published the results of the May 2009 examination. 1,180 candidates sat the exams of which 226 candidates attempted all four papers, and of these 116 (51%) passed all four papers.

The association president, David Stedman, said:

'I am pleased to congratulate all successful candidates in our May examination. A very high total of 2,414 papers were sat, and 1,592 passes were achieved in one or more of seven papers with 93 distinctions awarded for exceptional performance.
